Data Visualizations Update

The Office of Economic and Demographic Research (EDR) has begun creating data visualizations for many of the products available on the EDR site. Data visualization is the use of graphical representations to make data more accessible through the use of charts and graphs which allow the user to interact with the data in a meaningful way.

To the extent possible, EDR has standardized user navigation and interaction across all of the data visualizations. EDR has also created help screens to assist users in navigating the data visualizations.

A background color scheme has been developed to indicate the type of data used in each visualization. Below is a list of the background colors for the various types of data.

Color	Data Type
Grey	Statutorily required data
Green	Conference product data
Blue	Adopted forecast results
Mauve	Other data
