# Education Estimating Conference on Student Financial Aid EXECUTIVE SUMMARY 

August 11, 2022

The Student Financial Aid Estimating Conference met on August 11, 2022, to revise and extend estimates from FY 2021-22 through FY 2027-28 for student financial aid programs based on preliminary data for FY 2021-22 awards. The new estimates reflect data through July 19, 2022, and are compared to the December 2021 Conference estimates. Relative to FY 2021-22, all four currently forecasted programs are expected to grow, although somewhat unevenly. By FY 2027-28, the last year of the forecast horizon, the combined growth rate across programs is $8.4 \%$ over the current year.

Bright Futures Scholarships: Preliminary data show that there were 119,416 regular program awards in FY 202122 , an increase of 220 awards (or $0.2 \%$ ) from the December estimate. In addition, the Conference adopted an estimate of $\mathbf{5 , 5 0 2}$ awards for early summer enrollments of high school graduates who are initially eligible for an award in the 2022-23 academic year, but who opt instead to enroll early in the 2022 summer term. For the FY 2022-23 regular program, the Conference adopted $\mathbf{1 1 9 , 4 1 0}$ awards, an increase of 783 awards (or $0.7 \%$ ) over the previous estimate, as well as an estimated $\mathbf{5 , 5 0 2}$ early summer enrollments for the 2023 summer term. For the FY 2023-24 regular program, the Conference adopted $\mathbf{1 2 0 , 2 5 0}$ awards, and $\mathbf{5 , 9 4 0}$ early summer enrollments for the 2024 summer term. For FY 2024-25 and the years beyond, the forecast incorporates a slight shift between the Florida Academic Scholars (FAS) and Florida Medallion Scholars (FMS) programs within the Bright Futures Scholarship to account for changing admission test scores.

Effective Access to Student Education (EASE) Grants: Based on the preliminary data for FY 2021-22 and the previously adjusted participation changes, the Conference estimated that the total number of awards will be slightly lower than previously estimated in all comparable forecast years. The preliminary data indicate that there were 36,984 awards in FY 2021-22, a decrease of 214 (or $-0.6 \%$ ) awards relative to the previous estimate. For FY 2022-23, the Conference adopted 37,373 total awards, a decrease of 332 awards (or $-0.9 \%$ ) relative to the previous estimate. The Conference also adopted 37,728 total awards in FY 2023-24, a decrease of 466 awards (or $-1.2 \%$ ) relative to the previous estimate.

Children/Spouses of Deceased/Disabled Veterans (CSDDV): Preliminary data show that there were 2,750 awards in FY 2021-22, an increase of 49 awards (or 1.8\%) over the previous estimate. For FY 2022-23, the Conference adopted $\mathbf{3 , 0 7 9}$ projected awards, a decline of 81 awards (or $-2.6 \%$ ) over the December estimate. The Conference also adopted 3,368 projected awards for FY 2023-24, a decline of 176 awards (or -5.0\%) over the previous estimate.

Benacquisto Scholarship Program: Preliminary data indicate that there were 1,976 awards in FY 2021-22, an increase of 2 awards (or 0.1\%) over the December estimate. For FY 2022-23, the Conference adopted 2,003 projected awards, an increase of 11 awards (or $0.6 \%$ ) over the previous estimate. The Conference also adopted $\mathbf{2 , 0 2 5}$ projected awards for FY 2023-24, an increase of 17 awards (or $0.8 \%$ ) over the previous estimate.
