# Education Estimating Conference on Student Financial Aid EXECUTIVE SUMMARY 

August 11, 2023


#### Abstract

The Student Financial Aid Estimating Conference met on August 11, 2023, to revise and extend estimates from FY 2022-23 through FY 2028-29 for student financial aid programs based on preliminary actuals for FY 2022-23 and legislative changes. The new estimates reflect data through July 27, 2023, and are compared to the February 2023 Conference estimates. Relative to FY 2022-23, one forecasted program is expected to steadily increase during the forecast horizon (CSDDV) while another is expected to steadily decline (EASE). The other two forecasted programs have mixed results, with Bright Futures expected to dip slightly before ultimately increasing and Benacquisto exhibiting a seesaw pattern before ending higher. By FY 2028-29, the last year of the forecast horizon, the combined programs are expected to grant $5.5 \%$ more awards $(9,012)$ than FY 2022-23.


Bright Futures Scholarships: Preliminary data show that there were 117,160 regular program awards in FY 202223, an increase of 1,526 awards (or 1.3\%) from the February estimate. In addition, the Conference adopted 6,328 awards for early summer enrollments of high school graduates who were initially eligible for an award in the 2023-24 academic year, but who opted instead to enroll early in the 2023 summer term. This early enrollment associates them with the prior fiscal year. For the FY 2023-24 regular program, the Conference adopted 115,269 awards, an increase of 240 awards (or 0.2\%) over the previous estimate, as well as an estimated 6,877 early summer enrollments. For the FY 2024-25 regular program, the Conference adopted 116,542 awards, and 6,981 early summer enrollments.

Effective Access to Student Education (EASE) Grants: Preliminary data indicate that there were 35,308 awards in FY 2022-23, a decrease of 2,065 (or $-5.5 \%$ ) awards relative to the previous estimate. For FY 2023-24, the Conference adopted 35,293 total awards, a decrease of 2,435 awards (or $-6.5 \%$ ) relative to the previous estimate. The Conference also adopted 34,991 total awards in FY 2024-25, a decrease of 3,041 awards (or -8.0\%) relative to the previous estimate.

Children/Spouses of Deceased/Disabled Veterans (CSDDV): Preliminary data show that there were 3,512 awards in FY 2022-23, an increase of 136 award (or 4.0\%) over the previous estimate. For FY 2023-24, the Conference adopted 4,041 projected awards, an increase of 144 awards (or $3.7 \%$ ) over the February estimate. The Conference also adopted 4,531 projected awards for FY 2024-25, an increase of 185 awards (or 4.3\%) over the previous estimate.

Benacquisto Scholarship Program: Preliminary data indicate that there were 1,948 awards in FY 2022-23, an increase of 24 awards (or 1.2\%) over the previous estimate. For FY 2023-24, the Conference adopted 1,959 projected awards, an increase of 50 awards (or $2.6 \%$ ) relative to the previous estimate. The Conference also adopted 1,919 projected awards for FY 2024-25, a decrease of 1 award (or $-0.1 \%$ ) relative to the previous estimate. Variability in the projected growth of the Benacquisto Scholarship Program is related to the required phaseout of nonresidents from the program. The last initial nonresident students received awards in FY 2021-22 and the last renewal nonresidents will receive awards in FY 2025-26.
