


## ***FLORIDA ECONOMIC OUTLOOK***

*The Florida Economic Estimating Conference met in the Fall of 2006 to revise the forecast for the state's economy. As further updated by EDR, the latest forecast shows the economy expanding at a much more modest pace, significantly slower than the 2004-05 banner year. Population growth continues to be the state's primary engine of economic growth, fueling both employment and income growth. All comments are directed to the immediate planning horizon extending through Fiscal Year 2009-10.*

### **RECAP ~ Fiscal Year 2005-06 History**



The change in Gross State Product (GSP) is frequently used to compare states. While Florida has significantly outperformed the nation over the past six years, the last two years (2004 and 2005) have been greatly influenced by the inclusion of insurance payments arising from the 2004 and 2005 storms.

Other factors are used to gauge the health of an *individual state*. Typically, the two principal economic measures are income and employment growth. Since the 2006 version of this plan, these measures have shown that Florida grew at a slightly faster pace than originally thought a year ago. Personal income growth, initially estimated at 7.1%, ultimately reached 7.5% for FY 2005-06. Similarly, employment achieved 3.8% growth, even though the forecast only called for 3.6%.


While a few near-term projections were revised downward in the Spring forecast for 2005-06, the final results were somewhat mixed as gains achieved during the height of the real estate boom managed to hang on for several additional quarters. For example, both population growth and residential construction surpassed the forecast for last year. While the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation had originally reported that Florida “remains among the nation’s fastest growing states as population growth, tourism, and real estate-related industries propel the economy forward,” they were reporting some cracks in this picture by the end of the fiscal year.

For most of the year, the population growth, along with mortgage rates that hovered around 6.0% – lower than the National Economic Estimating Conference (NEEC) had originally projected – appeared to breathe life into residential construction activity. The Florida Economic Estimating Conference (FEEC) was expecting private housing starts to begin a decline in the early summer. In fact new activity stayed above the anticipated levels until the end of the fiscal year, although existing home sales began to falter in the fall. For Fiscal Year 2005-06, there were 271,300 starts, a 0.8% increase over the prior year. Much of this activity was in single family starts which ended up falling -1.2% from the prior year to a level of 179,800 units.

**FORECAST ~ Fiscal Years 2006-07 (base) through 2009-10**

**Income...**Nominal personal income is projected to grow 7.4% in Fiscal Year 2006-07. While healthier than the national forecast, Florida’s income growth is expected to slow again next year to 6.1% before beginning a gradual rebound. Per capita income as adjusted for inflation exhibits the same pattern—in real terms, income is expected to grow 2.8% this year, drop in Fiscal Year 2007-08 to 1.8 %, and then increase over the rest of the planning period to 3.4%. Much of the continued strength in personal income can be attributed to faster growth in wages and salaries due to upward pressure from the tightening labor market. However, property income and transfer payments also contribute strength. After several years of declines and suppressed activity arising from low interest rates and a stock market that was moving sideways, growth in property income is projected to average 8.4% this year. It is expected to continue climbing to 7.1% in Fiscal Year 2007-08, 9.8% in Fiscal Year 2008-09, and 10.3% in Fiscal Year 2009-10.

**Employment...**According to the latest nationwide data, Florida had the fastest job growth rate (2.8%) and lowest unemployment rate (3.1%) of the 10 most populous states. Overall employment is projected to grow just 2.3% in Fiscal Year 2006-07, further decline to 1.7% in Fiscal Year 2007-08, and then return to 2.7% for the rest of the forecast period.



Currently, the fastest growing industry in Florida is professional and business services. They are expected to add over a third of the new jobs forecast for Fiscal Year 2006-07. After growing 5.6% last year, this sector is projected to expand another 4.8% in Fiscal Year 2006-07. Next year, growth decelerates to 3.6% and then returns to 4.9% in Fiscal Year 2008-09. Slightly over half of the growth in this sector is concentrated in employment agencies, temporary help and leasing services, janitorial and cleaning services, exterminating and pest control services, and landscaping. In this respect, Florida is part of a national trend. According to the U.S. Department of Labor, the employment services sector is expected to be among those that provide the most new jobs. However, Florida differs from the nation in that our single fastest growing sector is **not** education and health services. In part, this is a data collection problem. Many companies providing temporary help and leasing services are actually benefiting the other employment sectors.

Three industry sectors are expected to shed jobs this year: natural resources and mining, manufacturing, and construction. Altogether 10,300 jobs will be adversely affected. Most of the loss will come from construction-related employment. After three years of phenomenal growth, this is consistent with the much weaker housing market forecast. Strength will not return to this industry during the forecast period, although growth returns in Fiscal Year 2008-09.

All other employment sectors are expected to expand, albeit somewhat modestly. While the information services sector gained jobs in Fiscal Year 2005-06 after losing jobs during each of the prior four years, the forecast calls for employment to increase an additional 0.5% this year and then further expand to 2.0% in 2007-08.

The overall unemployment rate is expected to reach 3.41% this year, higher than the 2005-06 banner year. From there it gradually rises to just over 3.6% as the labor force expands faster than the economy can absorb the new entrants and then drops back to 3.47%. Each of these levels is significantly less than the projected national averages. In October 2006, unemployment reached 4.4% nationally. Only five counties had unemployment rates higher than this: Madison, Hendry, Glades, Hardee and DeSoto.

**Construction...** Vigorous home price appreciation that outstripped gains in income and the use of speculative financing arrangements made Floridians particularly vulnerable to the decelerating housing market and interest rate risks. In 2006, almost 47% of all mortgages in the state were considered to be innovative (interest only and pay option ARM). With the federal funds rate standing at 5.25%, housing starts are well into a significant decline that continues through Fiscal Year 2007-08 before beginning a modest rebound. Single-family starts are in even worse shape, staying in a decline until Fiscal Year 2008-09. Total construction expenditures follow a similar pattern, never returning to the 2005-06 level during the forecast. Growth in private nonresidential construction is projected to accelerate to 10.1% this year, and then moderate in the out-years. Meanwhile, after posting a 7.8% increase last year, public construction activity is

projected to expand 5.7% this fiscal year and 6.2% next year, before stabilizing around that level.

***Population & Other***...Finally, the population growth rate of 2.25% for this year reflects the highest rate that will be achieved over the forecast period. Even so, the annual growth rate is expected to stay above 2% throughout the planning horizon. This allows Florida to stay on track to become the third largest state in the nation sometime between 2015 and 2020, surpassing New York. And by 2007, the state's age mix will shift for the first time to produce a higher percentage of persons aged 45-64 than persons aged 25-44, a phenomenon arising from the aging baby boom population.
