- (1) The statewide impact on the tax base would be -\$57.3m in 2008-09 , -\$116.3m in 2009-10 , and -\$177.1m in 2010-11 . The statewide tax losses shown are calculated using current statewide millage rates.
- (2) This bill also has a 2006-07 fiscal impact, identical to that in 2007-08.
- (3) Applies to Miami-Dade County only, and requires a voter referendum.
- (4) Level of refunds subject to appropriation.
