### **SECTION 1: NARRATIVE**

**a. Current Law:** Resident anglers must pay a \$7.50 annual fee for a shoreline fishing license, which is deposited into the Marine Resources Conservation Trust Fund. If they purchase it by telephone or over the internet, they are assessed a \$1.50 fee which is deposited into the State Game Trust Fund. If they purchase it directly from a county tax collector, they pay a \$1.50 fee, all of which stays with the tax collector. If they purchase it from a subagent, they are assessed a \$2.00 fee, \$1.00 of which goes to the State Game Trust Fund, \$.50 of which goes to the tax collector in the county in which the licenses is sold, and \$.50 is retained by the subagent.

**b. Proposed Change:** The \$7.50 fee for the license is eliminated for Florida residents. The \$1.50 fee for buying over the internet or by telephone is eliminated. The \$1.50 fee paid to a county tax collector is eliminated, but the tax collector gets to retain \$.50 from other fees due to Fish and Wildlife Commission (FWC) from other licenses and permits. The \$2.00 fee due to a subagent will be eliminated, but the subagent may retain \$.50 from other fees due to FWC.
