- (b) In return for compensation, offers or provides temporary household services or temporary remote services to third-party individuals or entities through the marketplace platform's technology application.
 (3) "Marketplace platform" or "platform" means an entity operating in this state which:
 (a) Offers an online-enabled technology application service, website, or system that enables marketplace contractor
 - service, website, or system that enables marketplace contractors to provide services to third-party individuals or entities seeking such temporary household services or temporary remote services.
 - (b) Accepts service requests from the public only through its online-enabled technology application service, website, or system.
 - (4) "Remote services" means:
 - (a) Tutoring;
 - (b) Closed captioning;
 - (c) Open captioning;
 - (d) Subtitling;
 - (e) Transcribing;
 - (f) Translating;
 - (g) Interpreting; or
 - (h) Conducting a language assessment.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2022.
