4 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

6 Section 1. Section 451.01, Florida Statutes, is amended to
7 read:

8 451.01 Definitions.—For purposes of this chapter, the term:

9 (1) "Household services" means:

10 (a) Furniture assembly;

11 (b) Interior painting;

12 (c) Television mounting;

13 (d) Local moving help, such as packing, lifting, loading,
14 and rearranging household items, but excluding transporting
15 items;

16 (e) Hanging pictures, mirrors, curtains, blinds, and
17 shelves;

18 (f) Home cleaning;

19 (g) Installation of in-home technology that does not
20 require a hardwired electrical connection; or

21 (h) Installing or replacing door hardware.

23 Household services do not include services that require
24 licensure under chapter 489.

25 (2) "Marketplace contractor" means any individual who:

26 (a) Enters into an agreement with a marketplace platform to
27 use the platform's technology application to connect with third-
28 party individuals or entities seeking temporary household
29 services or temporary remote services.

30 (b) In return for compensation, offers or provides
31 temporary household services or temporary remote services to
32 third-party individuals or entities through the marketplace
33 platform's technology application.

34 (3) "Marketplace platform" or "platform" means an entity
35 operating in this state which:

36 (a) Offers an online-enabled technology application
37 service, website, or system that enables marketplace contractors
38 to provide services to third-party individuals or entities
39 seeking such temporary household services or temporary remote
40 services.

41 (b) Accepts service requests from the public only through
42 its online-enabled technology application service, website, or
43 system.

44 (4) "Remote services" means:

45 (a) Tutoring;

46 (b) Closed captioning;

47 (c) Open captioning;

48 (d) Subtitling;

49 (e) Transcribing;

50 (f) Translating;

51 (g) Interpreting; or

52 (h) Conducting a language assessment.

53 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2022.
