

**Voluntary Prekindergarten Estimating Conference  
Executive Summary  
July 27, 2012**

The Voluntary Prekindergarten Estimating Conference met on July 27, 2012 to review final 2010-11 school year data; final summer 2011 data; preliminary 2011-12 school year data; and preliminary summer 2012 data and to adopt a forecast through 2015-16.

Final enrollment data for program year 2010-11 indicates that 76.5% of eligible four year olds participated in the VPK program. The participation rate is estimated to increase to 80.9% for the 2011-12 program year and reach 84.8% by the 2012-13 program year. The participation rate for the 2012-13 program year includes the impact of the Specialized Instructional Services Program (SISP) based on the assumptions listed below.

The assumptions for the forecasts through 2015-16 are:

- Participation rates will continue to increase reaching 88.9% by 2015-16.
- Excluding the SISP, enrollment in the summer program is expected to remain at 8,302, the same as summer 2011 enrollment, throughout the forecast time period. Round-up calculations for summers 2012 through the end of the forecast horizon are held constant at 2011 levels.
- Starting with the 2012-13 school year the Specialized Instructional Services Program will impact both enrolment and FTE for both school year and summer. The impact of this program will be phased in; with approximately 50% of the school year impact in 2012-13 and 100% in the remaining forecast school years and all summer periods.

The estimates and forecasts, starting with school year 2011-12, utilize the most recent ratio of enrollment to FTE (2011/2012 school year and 2011 summer). The changes in enrollment and FTE were due to revised forecasts of 4-year old population, participation rates, and enrollment to FTE ratios.

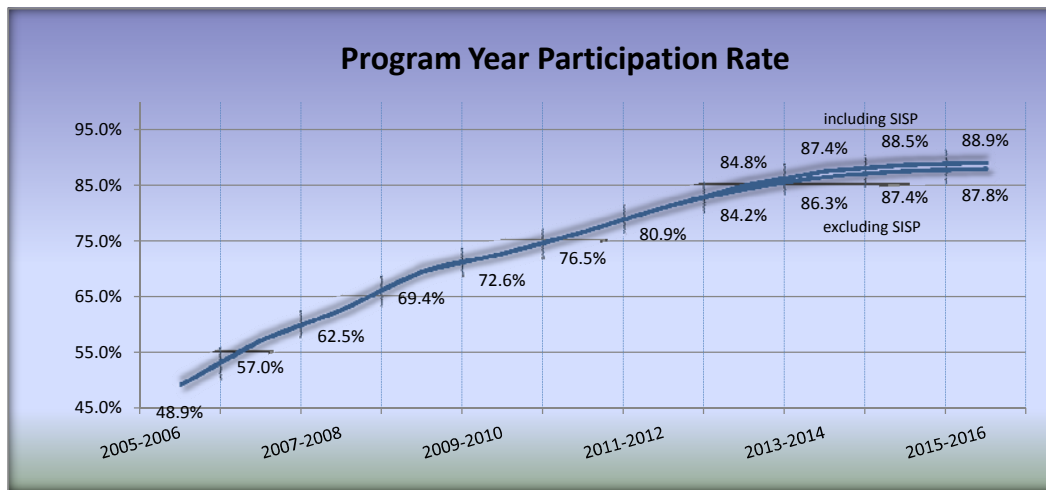

Participation Rate	Program Year enrollment divided by the estimated/forecasted October 1, population of 4-year olds.
Program Year	Includes the VPK School Year and Summer Programs based on eligibility as determined by date of birth.
Public School Round-up	The public school FTE enrollment round-up refers to adding enrollment to public school FTE enrollment if the level of enrollment is not a multiple of 12 for summer 2009 and beyond and a multiple of 10 for summers 2007 and 2008.
School Year	540 hour VPK Program that runs from July/August (varies by county) until May/June.
Summer	300 hour VPK Program that runs from May/June to July/August.
