The reported expenditures must indicate the source of such funds as federal, state, local, or other, as applicable.
- Many municipal governments, which reported financial data to EDR pursuant to s. 166.241, F.S., did not report any budgeted affordable housing expenditures.
- The separate statewide totals for the Calculated Expenditures by Funding Source do not sum to the statewide total of Reported Expenditure since Key West and Niceville did not report Funding Source by Percentage for their respective affordable housing expenditures.
