Senate Bill 2-C, as signed into law by Governor DeSantis on April 22, 2022, contains a provision directing the Office of Economic and Demographic Research (EDR) to make geographical information systems maps and block equivalency files for newly enacted congressional districts available to the public.

Attached are the geographical information systems maps and block equivalency files representing the boundaries of the congressional districts for the qualification, nomination, and election to the office of representative to the Congress of the United States in the primary and general elections held in 2022 and thereafter. These files serve as the official maps of the districts, and are formatted to be compatible with commonly used mapping software.
