EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Criminal Justice Estimating Conference, October 18, 2004

The Criminal Justice Estimating Conference convened October 18, 2004 to revise the forecast of prison admissions and populations. During the eight months since the last conference, admissions totaled 22,278, or 232 below the estimate. The population at the end of September 2004 was 82,141, or 178 below the estimate. However, the hurricanes in August and September impacted the criminal justice system, including closing certain courts and judicial proceedings for various lengths of time. Since admissions and population were lower because of the hurricanes, the situation at the end of July was also noted, when the population was 113 over the forecast. It was assumed that before the end of the current fiscal year, the shortfall from the hurricane months of August and September will be made up. The new adopted forecast from E.D.R. anticipates new commitments to grow 1.5% a year, tracking recent growth in guilty dispositions. The rapid growth of the past two years is expected to moderate, since it has been fueled by jumps in the incarceration rates of a few counties, often with overcrowded jails, while other large counties have shown flat or declining admissions.

Despite the increase in forecasted admissions from the February 2004 Conference, the new population forecast for FY 2008-09 was reduced slightly. This is because of the continued reduction in the average sentence length of prison admissions. In FY 2003-04 the average sentence length of all admissions declined to 4.7 years from 5 years in FY 2002-03. In part, the decline is attributable to the rise in technical violators of probation sentenced to prison, typically for short periods.
