Revenue Estimating Conference Slot Machine Revenues February 14, 2011 Executive Summary

The Revenue Estimating Conference meeting on Slot Machine revenues adopted revised estimates for tax revenues from slot machine operations for fiscal years 2010-11 through 2013-14, and adopted an estimate for 2014-15. The estimates of transfers to the Educational Enhancement Trust Fund were affected as follows:

The forecast reflects updated tax collections data and information concerning the number of machines in the currently operating facilities. Collections since the last conference (held in November 2010), after adjusting for a late January deposit, have been running slightly ahead of estimate, by a total of \$.1 million in the months November through January. The conference is projecting that in 2010-11 overall Net Win will increase by 28.9% over the 2009-10 fiscal year, but due to the decline in the tax rate from 50% to 35%, tax collections will actually fall by 9.7%. The conference expects that for the currently operating facilities, revenue will be somewhat below estimate for the rest of the current fiscal year, overall ending up at \$2.3 million below the November estimate.

For 2011-12, the opening date for Hialeah has remained unchanged from January 1, 2012, although the expected number of machines has been reduced from 1,000 to 800, based on the most recent plans submitted by the facility. Revenues for that facility are projected to be \$3.3 million below the current estimate. The November projections did not include any revenues from Miami Jai-Alai, but recent information indicates that they will be opening around the beginning of 2012, and the new projected revenues of \$9.0 million anticipate a January 1, 2012 opening date. Overall the projected revenues for the currently operating facilities are expected to be \$4.1 million below the previous estimate. Net win and tax collections for those facilities overall are expected to increase by 1.0% over 2010-11, compared to the 2.5% in the previous forecast. Overall the 2011-12 gain from the previous forecast is \$1.5 million.

For 2012-13 and 2013-14, tax collections are expected to be higher than the previous forecast by \$7.4 million and \$2.5 million, respectively, with the addition of Miami Jai-Alai revenues accounting for \$9.0 million in 2012-13 and \$17.3 million in 2013-14. In 2014-15, collections are expected to be \$167.2 million, growing by 1.7% over 2013-14.
