General Revenue Collections for March 2003

Preliminary General Revenue (GR) collections for March March were \$11.1 M over the new March 2003 estimate. (The General Revenue Estimating Conference (GREC) met on March 14, 2003; estimates from that conference are shown in this report.) Preliminary Sales Tax was under estimated.

February Lottery Transfers to DOE

Month: \$79.8 million, \$2.6 million above Feb 2003 estimate Year: \$657.9 million, \$2.6 million above Feb 2003 estimate \$62.7 million above Jan 2002 estimate mate by \$2.4 M for the month, standing now at \$6.0 M under estimate for the year. The only other source significantly under estimate was Intangibles Taxes, which was \$30.9 M under estimate for the month. Total Intangibles collections had been runnina over estimate through February, largely due to the portion of the tax that comes from refinancing; a single distribution is made to GR each month. Intangibles Taxes total collections were under estimate by \$12.0 M this month. amount transferred to GR is partly dependent upon

when the transfer is made each month. At least part of this month's shortfall appears to be a timing effect. Refunds were over estimate by \$4.8 M (mostly in Sales Tax refunds), which decreases Net GR.

On the other hand, Corporate Income Tax was over estimate by \$33.1 M, continuing its good performance for the year. Documentary Stamps Tax total collections were \$17.0 M over estimate, and the transfer to GR was \$13.5 M over estimate. Most other sources were very close

to the new estimates.

To summarize. Net GR collections for were \$11.1 M over estimate for the month and \$7.5 M over estimate for the fiscal year, with most sources close to estimates.
