Preliminary General Revenue Collections for January 2006

Preliminary General Revenue (GR) collections for January 2006 were \$142.7 M over the November Revenue Estimating Conference (REC) 2005 estimates. All of the large sources came in over estimate this month. Preliminary Sales Tax GR was \$61.9 M over estimate for the month. Sales Tax receipts from every category exceeded the month's estimates. For the year to date, Sales Tax GR is \$38.6 M, or about threetenths of one percent, over estimate. Corporate Income Tax was \$25.8 M over estimate, and now stands at a little over 4% ahead of estimate for the year to date. Because of last year's law change in distributions, there was no Documentary Stamp Tax distribution to General Revenue this month. However, for the year to date, total collections of Documentary Stamp Tax are now running about 2% over Intangibles Taxes estimate. again exceeded estimates for the month due to the continued good performance of that portion of the tax related to liens secured by Florida realty. Other Taxes and Fees, a collection of many small sources, was \$28.4 M over estimate this month, due to a much larger than expected transfer to GR from Article V (court-related) fees.

Only six sources fell below estimate for the month. Among the largest, Medical Hospital Fees (reimbursements from counties to the state for Medicaid expenditures primarily for nursing homes) continue to fall below estimate. County billings appear to be on target, and reimbursements should eventually close this gap. Premium Tax stands \$3.9 M under estimate for the year due to smaller than expected Surplus Lines receipts. Refunds were under estimate again this month by \$13.5 M, which adds to the Net GR bottom line.

To summarize, Net GR collections for January were \$142.7 M over the November 2005 estimate for the month and \$185.2 M over estimate for the year to date. All estimates in the table below are based on the General Revenue Estimating Conference held November 15, 2005.
