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General Revenue Collections for January 2009 (Sales Tax Data Reported is Unaudited))

General Revenue (GR) collections for January 2009 were \$131.0 M under the estimates adopted by the General Revenue Estimating Conference (GR REC) on November 21, 2008. Sales Tax GR was \$92.7 M (about 5.9%) under estimate for the month. All six Sales Tax components came in under estimate again this month. The largest shortfall was in Tourism, which fell \$21.5 M (about 6.3%) under estimate for the month, followed by Business at \$19.0 M or about 5.6% under estimate and Consumer Non-Durables at \$17.9 M or about 2.7% under estimate. The Automobiles component was \$17.5 M or about 7.6% under estimate; the Other Durables component was \$10.4 M or about 7.4% under estimate; and Building was \$8.6 M or about 10.0% under estimate for the month.

A little over half of the remaining GR sources also came in under estimate for the month. Among the larger shortfalls, Medical Hospital Fees were

under estimate by \$24.1 M. This shortfall resulted from billing delays associated with a change-over in the Medicaid fiscal agent, mainly in the hospital claims area. It is likely that Medical Hospital Fees will fall short of estimate this year because of timing of payments due to the delay Service Charges were in billing. \$15.8 M under estimate; the expected \$8.8 M Department of Financial Services Trust Funds Service Charge transfer did not show up until February. (The transfer itself was \$6.8 M.) The remainder of the Service Charge shortfall came from Other Service Charges, a large group of many small transfers from trust funds in all agencies. Insurance Premium Tax was \$7.4 M under estimate, again due to timing; an \$8.0 M Surplus Lines payment was received on the first day of February. Although Corporate Income Tax fell \$9.6 M under estimate for January, this source remains \$26.3 M over estimate for the year to date.

On the plus side of the ledger, Article V Fees and Transfers (funding for Florida's state courts) were back on track at \$11.7 M over estimate, making up for last month's shortfall as expected. Refunds were \$7.5 M under estimate, which adds to GR's bottom line.

To summarize, Net GR collections for January were \$131.0 M under estimate for the month and \$216.6 M under estimate for the 2008-09 fiscal year.
