

FLORIDA MONTHLY ECONOMIC REPORT

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GENERAL REVENUE COLLECTIONS FOR MAY

General Revenue (GR) collections for May were \$40.2 M over estimates adopted at the April 2000 Revenue Estimating Conference (REC). Sales Tax GR was \$34.3 M over estimate for the month, again primarily due to larger than expected audit assessments. (Recall that distributions are made from total Sales Tax Collections to local governments, the Solid Waste Management Trust Fund, and various sports facilities as well as to the General Revenue Fund.) For the year to date, Sales Tax GR is \$64.2 M (about 0.5%) over estimate. The Corporate Income Tax recouped some of last month's shortfall, ending

\$30.5 over estimate for the month, but still \$54.1 M under estimate for the year. Intangibles Taxes again exceeded estimates, \$10.2 M over estimate for the month, with total collections in this source standing \$27.4 M over estimate for the year to date.

On the down side, Documentary Stamp Tax GR was \$6.7 M under estimate; however, total collections are \$16.9 M over estimate for the year. Distributions to GR should eventually catch up. Most sources remain essentially on track for the year. The big variance was in Refunds, which came in \$26.8 M over estimate this month, primarily from uncommonly large Estate Tax and Sales Tax refunds. Refunds are expected to return to estimated levels next month.

Overall, Net GR collections for May were \$40.2 M over estimate

for the month and \$1.4 M over estimate for the fiscal year to date, based on estimates from the April 2000 REC. All estimates in the table below are based on the General Revenue Estimating Conference that met on April 7.
