General Revenue Collections for October

General Revenue (GR) collections for October were \$50.1 M over estimates adopted at the recent October 24, 2000 Revenue Estimating Conference (REC). Preliminary Sales Tax GR was \$25.8 M over the new estimate for

(Recall that distributions are made from total Sales Tax Collections to local governments, the Solid Waste Management Fund, and various sports facilities as well as to the General Revenue Fund. Beginning this year, revenue sharing with municipalities and counties is being distributed from total Sales Tax Collections rather than from Cigarette Intangibles Taxes, Taxes, and Pari-mutuel Taxes.) New monthly estimates for all sources are based on the results.

of the October REC, which added \$41 M (two-tenths of one percent) to the GR estimate for the current fiscal year. Most sources came in virtually on target for the month.

The only sources under estimate for the month were: Beverage Taxes (which include both the By-the-Drink Tax and the Beverage Excise Tax, under estimate by \$3.7 M for the month); Other Taxes and Fees (a multitude of small fees, under by only \$0.6 M); and Tobacco Taxes (which

include both Tobacco and Other Tobacco Products, under by only \$0.3 M). Although Refunds fell \$15.3 M under estimate for the month, shortfalls in this source act to increase Net GR.

Overall, Net GR collections for October were \$50.1 M over estimate for the month and \$50.6 M over estimate for the fiscal year. All estimates in the table below are based on the most recent General Revenue Estimating Conference that met on October 24, 2000.
