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General Revenue Collections for November 2008 (Sales Tax Data Reported is Unaudited))

General Revenue (GR) collections for November 2008 were \$26.4 M under the new estimates adopted by the General Revenue Estimating Conference (GR REC) held November 21, 2008. Sales Tax GR was \$21.0 M under the new estimate for the month. The components of Sales Tax falling short of the new estimates were Consumer Non-Durables (\$5.2 M or about 1.2% under estimate), Other Durables (\$4.0 M or about 4.2% under estimate), and Automobiles (\$3.7 M or about 1.8% under estimate). The Tourism, Building, and Business components were all on estimate or slightly over for the month. However, sales tax collections were affected by a technical adjustment of \$35.76 M against CST that was expected in December. Because the negative adjustment was made earlier than expected, next month's collections for CST should be higher than originally projected while the estimates for the year should be back on track.

The remaining GR sources were a mixed bag. Intangibles Taxes fell \$1.0 M under the new estimate, while total collections in the Documentary Stamp Tax came in \$6.6 M under the new estimate. Both of these sources are continuing to be affected by weakness in the housing market. Corporate Income Tax GR was also under estimate by \$8.8 M, showing the effects of the economic slow-down. Service Charges to GR were \$3.7 M under estimate, with timing of transfers to GR from DFS being the culprit. Other Taxes and Fees and Drivers License Fees were also under estimate (\$7.3 M and \$1.7 M respectively).

On the upside, Interest Earnings came in \$2.9 M over the new estimate for the month. Medical Hospital Fees were \$9.4 M over estimate, and the Tobacco Tax collections were up coming in \$3.6 M over estimate. Small increases of \$1.7 M from Beverage Taxes, \$1.7 M in Corporate Filing Fees, and \$1.4 M in Article V Fees were also received. Everything else was largely on estimate.

Refunds were under estimate: however, Refund shortages increase GR's net bottom line. Refunds were \$1.1 M under estimate for the month due to lighter than expected Sales Tax refunds.

To summarize, Net GR collections for November were \$26.4 M under estimate for the month and for the 2008-09 fiscal year. The table below is based on the new monthly estimates from the November 21, 2008 GR Estimating Conference.
