

CS/SB 1632 – Ideologies Inconsistent with American Principles (Similar HB 1471)

This bill amends and creates multiple statutes related to terrorism. It creates s. 943.03102, F.S. pertaining to designation of terrorist organizations, where the Chief of Domestic Security may designate an organization as a domestic terrorist organization or foreign terrorist organization, given specific criteria for each. It also adds domestic terrorist organization to s. 775.30, F.S., s. 775.32, F.S., s. 775.33, F.S., and s. 775.34, F.S., where these statutes contain felonies related to terrorism.

Per DOC, in FY 24-25, there were no new commitments to prison for the felonies impacted by the expanded statutory language under this bill. The magnitude of the impact on the prison population from the addition of domestic terrorist organization is not known, nor is it known how the labeling of such groups by the Chief of Domestic Security would influence the number of offenders associated with domestic and foreign terrorist organizations potentially being incarcerated.
