

## **HB 387 – Sexual Predators and Offenders (Identical SB 336)**

Creates s. 921.2312, F.S., requiring a court to order a mandatory curfew (7 p.m. to 7 a.m.) as a condition of probation or community control for offenders who commit certain sex offenses on or after October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2015. The current curfew hours are 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Per DOC, in FY 13-14, 174 offenders under sex offender probation were sentenced to prison for a technical violation and 1,570 offenders under community control were sentenced to prison for a technical violation. The number under sex offender probation that violated curfew and the number of sex offenders under community control that violated curfew cannot be determined. It is possible that the expansion of the curfew an additional four hours might increase the number of offenders that violate this order.
